There are also MOS sessions - routine oral surgical procedures under local anaesthetic and outpatient clinics. Countess of Chester, The OMFS unit at Chester acts as a spoke unit for the Regional Unit at Aintree. In addition to oral and maxillofacial duties, the DCT may also attend consultant clinics in orthodontics. There are joint multidisciplinary clinics for dentofacial deformity, oral medicine and dermatology, chronic facial pain.
