I worked in Pinderfields Hospital under Mr David Mitchell for eighteen months and under Mr Woodward for six months. I then decided to go into General dental practice in Manchester and worked in the same practice for seven years. During this tenure I attended the Paul Tipton course for restorative/cosmetic dentistry as that is my area of special interest. I am training to become an Invisalign provider at the moment and plan to introduce implant placement services over the next year. Our practice is a modern practice computerised (SOE) & with digital x-ray. The staff are really friendly. They have been at the practice for a long time - the receptionist for 45 years & Practice Manager for 38 years she joined the practice when she was 18! The nurses are all friendly and helpful.
