- Non-technical skills training, especially decision making, team-working and leadership.
- Staff resilience.
- Cognitive function.
- Empowering and confidence to seek help.
- Basic/advanced/neonatal/paediatric resuscitation training (depending on delegate needs).
- Deteriorating patient/collapsed patient – to include sepsis, haemorrhage, plus other scenarios as relevant to delegates.
- Team-working, leadership and self-confidence focus.
