Devonshire Park Dental Centre is a 4 surgery purpose built practice in Birkenhead, Wirral, 10 minutes from Liverpool city centre by car.

We are part of a partnership with another training practice in Claughton, and at this location have 4 dentists and a dental therapist. We are predominantly NHS and are in a high needs area. There are 2 managers who work as a team across both practices. There are longstanding nursing staff who are experienced working alongside FDs and a head nurse who works with the FD in the first few months. We have a receptionist and currently two trainee nurses at Devonshire Park.

The surgeries are large and fully equipped with all required dental equipment including rotary endo and apex locator. The practice is fully computerised with digital radiographs and has a separate split decontamination room. We have been a BDA good practice for more than ten years and have recently gained the Pride in Practice award.
