Programme Information	<p>The KSS School of Psychiatry ensures that training is delivered in line with the RCPsychiatrists' curriculum, towards doctors' passing the College examinations for successful exit from the programme.</p> <p>Each Core training programme is based in one of our three Mental Health Trusts (each covering a county) and placements include general adult and older adult psychiatry, eating disorders, PICU, CAMHS, LD, Substance Misuse, Liaison, Psychotherapy, Rehabilitation and Forensic Psychiatry.</p> <p>Core Psychiatry doctors complete the psychotherapy training in each programme, and access the regional MRCPsych (with funding support for a PGCert, and MSc) and completion.
