All Trainees receive one hour of protected supervision with their Educational Supervisor and all Trainees' timetables are designed to allow them guaranteed access to the Severn Core Psychiatry Training Course. The CT3 year is focused around specialist psychiatric training, including experience in Forensic Psychiatry, Learning Disability Psychiatry, Child and Adolescent Psychiatry, Addiction Psychiatry, Psychotherapy, Liaison Psychiatry, Rehabilitation Psychiatry and Neuropsychiatry.
