<b>Programme Details</b>	<p>During the first two years of training, there is an emphasis on general adult and old age psychiatry including a broad range of community based psychiatry and developmental psychiatry.</p> <p>The CT3 year is focused around specialist psychiatric training. <b>Expected Rotation Information</b>	<p>For the first two years, trainees are placed in a 'sub rotation' in a defined geographical area, with a Tutor allocated to each area. During these first two years, there is an emphasis on general adult and old age psychiatry including a broad range of community based psychiatry and developmental psychiatry. Each post lasts for six months.</p> <p>The CT3 year is focused around specialist psychiatric training, including experience in Forensic Psychiatry, Learning Disability Psychiatry, Child and Adolescent Psychiatry, Addiction Psychiatry, Psychotherapy, Liaison Psychiatry, Rehabilitation Psychiatry and Neuropsychiatry. During their final Core Training year, trainees are also expected to spend one session per week in a 'special interest' session, in order to broaden their experience of the specialities.</p>
