<b>Specialty &amp; Level (type of work)</b>	CT1 Psychiatry
<b>Programme Details</b>	The Core Psychiatry training programme is a 3 year programme, starting at CT1
<b>Role Description</b>	<p>During the 3-year programme, the trainee's work will be monitored for satisfactory progress and subject to annual reviews in the form of ARCPs. Progression on the programme will be dependent upon these reviews.</p> <p>Clinical care will be delivered at a range of sites requiring trainees to travel effectively and efficiently to, for example: Trust sites, patients' homes, police stations, clinics and other associated sites. Travel costs from base location to other sites will only be reimbursed for business mileage (valid insured drivers/vehicles) and journeys using all forms of public transport (including taxis) will be reimbursed at the public transport rate.</p> <p>The posts on this rotation have been approved for Specialist Training by the GMC &amp; RCPsych. The programme is designed to equip the trainee for Higher Specialist Training in their chosen specialty.</p> <p>The Postgraduate Dean has confirmed that this post has the necessary educational and staffing approvals.</p> <p>The programme is based in several different Trusts throughout Health Education Thames Valley, and trainees may find themselves in any of the following locations:</p>

CT1 allocations will be decided by Oriol subpreferencing facility; CT2 and CT3 placements are decided by annual preference exercise.

Future placements will usually be based on individual training and educational needs. <b>Please note that applications are to the Health Education Thames Valley as a whole.
