<p>Programme Details</p>	<p>Health Education England – Thames Valley covers the counties of Oxfordshire, Berkshire and Buckinghamshire, with Banbury and Milton Keynes to the north, Oxford towards the west, Aylesbury to the East, and Reading and Slough in the south/south-east.</p> <p>HEETV is relatively small and serves as a single unit of application. This means that in the first year you may be allocated to any geographic location within HEETV, depending on available placements.
