CT1 Psychiatry: North East Deanery		
Programme Details	Within Health Education North East the Core Psychiatry rotation is divided into a Northern Rotation and a Southern Rotation. The Northern scheme is the larger of the two core schemes with 48 posts. The majority of which are hosted by Northumberland Tyne and wear NHS Foundation Trust (NTW). NTW is one of the largest mental health and disability Trusts in the country – serving a population of 1.4 million. The Southern scheme with 37 core training posts is based at Tees, Esk and Wear Valley NHS Foundation Trust. This is a Specialist Mental Health Trust that provides comprehensive mental health services to the populations of County Durham, Teesside and part of North Yorkshire

Expected Rotation Information	Northern Rotation Rotating every six months; the majority of posts are based within NTW with a small number of posts within Northumbria Healthcare (NH) and Gateshead Health NHS Trust (GH). Whilst trainees within the Core (North) scheme may throughout their training, be based at any of the NTW locations (particularly for specialist services and developmental psychiatry), there is an expectation that the posts within CT1 will be within the same geographical area or hospital base. http://www.ntw.nhs.uk/ Southern Rotation This programme rotates every 6 months. To start off their experience in psychiatry, core trainees in their first rotation are assigned to a post which includes an adult mental health setting.
