Programme Details	<p>The Child and Adolescent Training Programme offers training to trainees who have passed their MRCPsych and wish to become Consultants in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry.</p> <p>The course is fully recognised by the Deanery and GMC and is based on the current Competency Based Curriculum.</p> <p>There is ample opportunity to undertake research during the three year training period with regular contributions from the Academic Unit in Cardiff. Expected Rotation Information	<p>3 x 12 month posts rotating throughout hospitals in South or North Wales. Once appointed to a programme a trainee will remain in that programme for the duration. Trainees do not rotate between North and South.</p> <p><u>ST4 General Adult Psychiatry</u> Wales offers an excellent range of training posts in General Adult Psychiatry in various locations including North and South Wales and offers the full spectrum of training. Subspecialty interests include Liaison and Substance Misuse Psychiatry. Training locations in the South are in West Wales, South Wales and South East and in North Wales based in Wrexham, Rhyl and Bangor. Trainees will work in a variety of geographical areas including urban, semi-rural and rural settings. This allows trainees to gain a width of experience across general adult psychiatry.</p> <p><u>ST4 Old Age Psychiatry</u> Old Age Psychiatry comes under the same Programme Director as General Adult and placements are in the same locations.</p> <p><u>ST4 Forensic Psychiatry</u> This is a three year programme based in a medium secure hospital - Caswell Clinic in Bridgend. Trainees spend three months of their final year in a high secure placement as part of their programme.</p>

	<p><u>ST4 Psychiatry of Learning Disability</u></p> <p>LD Psychiatry moved to a new curriculum in 2014 aimed at providing the framework to train Consultant Psychiatrists for practice in the UK to the level of CCT registration and beyond and is an add-on to the Core Curriculum. Specialists in the Psychiatry of Learning Disability work with others to assess, manage and treat people with mental health problems together with learning disabilities. They contribute to the development and delivery of effective services for people with these co-existing conditions.</p>
