Expected Rotation Information	Core training in Psychiatry is of three years duration made up of six month posts. For the first two years, everyone is rotated through General Adult Psychiatry in a limited geographical area with more complex posts in the second year. Then in the third year, trainees are expected to do some traveling away from their initial locality to broaden their educational experience in sub-specialty psychiatry.
