6	Travel Commitment	A successful candidate will need to be able to travel to different sites depending on the rotation.
7	Primary Care Element	Primary care placements will be delivered within the community sites of Blackpool Teaching Hospitals Foundation trust (BTH) and Lancashire and South Cumbria NHS Foundation Trust (LSCFT)
8	Description of the training post	This post will offer the StR a wide range of clinical experience. A successful candidate will have access to a wide range of Consultants and Specialists in Special Care Dentistry. The training programme will be mainly based within primary care with attachments as necessary to the local acute hospital units for specific aspects of the curriculum.  A successful candidate will have access to most forms of sedation in both a primary care (LSCFT) and in secondary care (LTHTR). Sedation is provided for all SCD groups by a mixture of dentist led sedation and anaesthetist delivered lists.  In hospital SCD units are located at Royal Preston, Royal Blackburn and at Chorley and South Ribble Hospital.  The StR will access SCD GA services with many Specialists and Consultants in SCD. GA services are based at Blackpool Victoria Hospital, Royal Preston Hospital, Chorley and South Ribble Hospital and Royal Blackburn Hospital.  The trainee will be encouraged and supported to attend relevant conferences such as those hosted by the British Society for Special Care Dentistry, British Society of Gerodontology, and the Society for Advancement of Anaesthesia in Dentistry.  There is a well-developed MCN in Special Care Dentistry in the area which will give an StR many options for QI projects and management and leadership experience.
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9	Educational programme and library facilities.	In line with the Special Care Dentistry Curriculum, the training programme will include at least 60% direct clinical care and 20% is protected for study, audit, and research, and administrative tasks relevant to patient care. If it has not been undertaken previously, the trainee will be encouraged to undertake a Diploma in Special Care Dentistry or a relevant alternative post-graduate qualification.  Regional Teaching: The regional specialty education programme provides specialty clinical teaching to ensure all aspects of the curriculum are covered. The trainee will be allowed time to attend all these teaching sessions.  Ad-hoc or period training opportunities: Occasionally there may be training opportunities available as single or infrequent training opportunities. Every effort will be made to ensure trainees are able to attend these opportunities.  If a trainee is found to have insufficient clinical experience in any area the rotation and timetable will be adjusted to meet their specific requirements. This will take place following logbook reviews, trainer feedback and ARCPs and the trainee will be involved in the planning to meet clinical targets.
