CT1 Psychiatry: West Midlands	
	Core Psychiatry training in the West Midlands offers trainees a full range of teaching, learning and experience both clinical and non-clinical.
Programme Details	Trainees are allocated to a cluster of CT1 level and are expected to remain within the cluster for the duration of their core training. The five geographic clusters within the region are: Birmingham Black Country Staffordshire & Shropshire Coventry & Warwickshire Worcestershire & Herefordshire
	Each cluster is able to deliver a range of experience in psychiatry that is required for assessment and examination purposes.
	Staffordshire and Shropshire Cluster: consisting of North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare Trust and South Staffordshire and Shropshire Foundation Trust
	Coventry and Warwickshire Cluster: which is served by Coventry and Warwickshire Partnership Trust
Training Locations	3. Hereford and Worcester Cluster: consisting of 2gether Trust in Hereford and Worcestershire Health and Care Trust
	Black Country Cluster: which consists of Dudley and Walsall Partnership Trust and Black Country Partnership Trust
	5. Birmingham Cluster: consisting of Birmingham and Solihull Mental Health Foundation Trust, Birmingham Children's Hospital Foundation Trust and Birmingham Community Trust
	All trainees will be in 6 month placements throughout core training. Their placements will be organised to meet their requirements as well as make sure the curriculum is covered.
Expected Rotation Information	Posts will usually be community mental health teams, in-patients/ home treatment teams, old age psychiatry at year 1 progressing to more specialist posts in child and adolescent mental health, learning disability, liaison psychiatry at year 2 and then on to further sub-specialties such as neuropsychiatry, assertive outreach, early intervention, eating disorders, psychotherapy and forensic at year 3.
	Trainees will likely stay within the same area throughout their rotation in core training.
