Programme Details	<p>Yorkshire and the Humber School of Psychiatry hosts well established Higher Training schemes in all psychiatric specialities. The schemes include placements across the region with the training coordinated from the main centres in Leeds, York, Wakefield, Bradford and Sheffield. It has developed innovative dual CCT training in General Adult combined with other specialities including Old Age and Medical Psychotherapy.
