

# **MLEF FAQs**

## Will this module be funded by HEE (NW)?

Yes, HEE (NW) will cover the full cost of the programme. Please be aware that the **cancellation policy** will apply to the modules and other funded days.

### Will I be allocated additional study leave to undertake this programme?

No, it is anticipated that the programme can be completed within your study leave allowance:

- Academic element The contact days for attendance on the PG cert modules at Edgehill University would vary depending on the options you choose. As a guideline they are normally equivalent to two or three one-day, face-to-face sessions per module so between 6-9 days over two years.
- Clinical no study days required.
- **Vocational element** between 2-5 days per annum depending on what opportunities you choose to participate in.

#### Will I continue training while on this programme?

Yes, the MLEF programme will run alongside your training; please bear this in mind when you apply.

## Can I apply if I am Less Than Full Time?

As with all applicants, subject to the approval of your Training Programme Director, then yes. Please be aware that LTFT Fellows are expected to complete the fellowship within the same timescale as other Fellows.

Would I be able to take time out of the programme if I was affected by mitigating circumstances and re-join on a later cohort?

Yes, but you would need to make your TPD and HEE aware of this. Any time out granted would be subject to the approval and agreement of your fellowship supervisor.

What do I need to do if my TPD is absent and I am unable to get their authorisation?

Speak to your Educational Supervisor and Head of School, and ask them to contact facultydevelopment.nw@hee.nhs.uk

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## Can I apply if I am out of programme?

Although you will need to be on a HEE (NW) training programme when you start the Fellowship, you can still apply while OOP as long as your training will restart by 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019.

What If I have already completed one (or more) of the Edge Hill University modules that are part of the Fellowships?

HEE (NW) will fund alternative modules at EHU, as long as you have provided evidence that they are still relevant to your chosen pathway. These modules will be agreed between you and your fellowship supervisor.
