- 95% re-enter training programmes within 3 years of completing foundation

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# Career taster posts – critically evaluate for your future

- Does it fit with my values?
- Does it use my preferred skills?
- Acute vs long term relationships with patients?
- Team elements?

- Do I like both training and senior roles?
- Lifestyle
- Would a non-Consultant role suit me best?
- Future of specialty?

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# Career taster posts – critically evaluate for your future

- Identify Responsible officer use GMC guide
- Indemnity
- Portfolio- consider college ones(charge)
- Consider having PDP

- Appraisal and using MAG form
- If non-clinical? Keeping up skills and appraisal

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# Skills Tutors and Anatomy Demonstrators

- University or trust adverts often late in year
- Make direct contact
- Does it include some clinical and opportunity for study for PG Cert etc
- What about appraisal?

- Is it a short year? (September to June)
- Related to a long term goal ?

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### **Locum considerations**

- Do you know and understand that working environment- induction
- Do you have contact number in case you are delayed
- Are you doing CPD? Use e-learning that is free
- Record expenses

- Many are for nights and weekends
- Set a maximum number of hours a week you will work
- Are you keeping proper accounts?

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#### Locum considerations

- Put aside finance for sick leave that you will not be paid for
- Suitable for supporting application for speciality
- Who is your RO and how will you get appraised?

- Locums
- VSO, Red Cross, MSF
- Agencies
- Health
- Registration GMC and abroad

- Indemnity
- Training for unfamiliar health care areas
- Remember start dates are often out of sync with UK

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### How to apply for non UK jobs

- Aid organisations and global health agencies
- Local recruitment outside UK
- UK agencies recruiting for jobs outside UK
- BMJ website
- Networking / contacts

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# **Going outside UK**

- Ask GMC re registration and licence to practice
- Indemnity will they cover you?
- Have you got health cover?
- Special vaccinations / malaria prophylaxis
- Accommodation
- Travel
- Do you need health checks before going who will pay?

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# Returning to training

- Oriel application dates
- Support with application forms
- Portfolio preparation plus time out information
- Interview practice
- Returning for interviews or going abroad after?
- Do less than 2 years in specialty before core application
- Fully back on register
- Evidence for revalidation from time out
- Do you need a mentor for returning to UK training?

- Record all educational activity Feedback
- Plan to attend suitable courses •
- Post graduate exams
- Leadership
- specific skills
- **Publications**
- Consider other qualifications- educational
