7	Primary Care Element	<i>Primary care elements will be delivered within the community clinics of Salford Community Dental Service and Manchester Community Dental Services</i>
8	Description of the training post	<p><i>The trainee will be exposed to patients of varying complexity, including those with the most complex needs requiring multidisciplinary inpatient care. Different patient cohorts will be encountered in other specialties and in placements within the Community Dental Services.</i></p> <p><i>The trainee will be exposed to Tier 2 and Tier 3 services for special care dentistry, so will be trained and supported to assess patients and provide appropriate care in community and hospital settings.</i></p> <p><i>The trainee will be encouraged and supported to attend relevant conferences such as those hosted by the British Society for Special Care Dentistry, British Society of Gerodontology, and the Society for Advancement of Anaesthesia in Dentistry.</i></p> <p><i>Conscious sedation is provided at the Dental Sedation Suite Manchester Royal Infirmary: and will expose the trainee to sedation provided by special care dentistry and oral surgery teams. There are multiple IACSD accredited trainers within the service who can support a trainee in gaining sedation experience.</i></p> <p><i>In addition to dental care delivered under local anaesthesia at University Dental care under local anaesthesia is also provided at the Manchester Royal Infirmary for medically complex and unstable patients, including those needing haematological or immunology support. The trainee would be involved in planning and coordinating such care.</i></p> <p><i>GA is provided at Trafford General Hospital (day case) and Manchester Royal Infirmary (day case and inpatient). The trainee will gain experience to a range of types of patients with a range of needs, including those receiving multidisciplinary inpatient care.</i></p> <p><i>The trainee will gain an increasing degree of independence and confidence as their time in post continues, and will be able to develop leadership skills through this progression. The trainee will be invited to the regional MCN meetings to support them in supporting service development, locally and regionally.</i></p>
