The placement also offers opportunities to gain experience in research. Registrars can get involved in research being undertaken across the Epidemiology and Public Health Group including molecular epidemiology, occupational and environmental health and drug evidence.

### ORGANISATION OF TRAINING

The registrar is assigned an educational supervisor with whom they will agree a work plan based on the learning outcomes that need to be achieved and there is regular contact between the supervisor and the registrar.

### FACILITIES

The expectation for all staff, including registrars on placement to work in the office at least two days per week. Registrars will be provided with a desk and a laptop which you can take to and from the office. Work from home is via VPN.
