8 Description of the training post

The trainee will follow a 2 year full time period of clinical training or part-time equivalence pro-rata. Towards the end of the training period, the trainee will be required to pass the Intercollegiate Specialty Fellowship Examination in Paediatric Dentistry (ISFE), the end-point of Higher Specialist training. At the completion of training, the trainee will be eligible for appointment to a Consultant post in Paediatric Dentistry.

The outline training programme has been approved by the Specialist Advisory Committee in Paediatric Dentistry and the Dean for Postgraduate Dentistry, NHS England, North West. Training would be based at any of the sites listed above. The successful candidate will take part in all aspects of clinical governance activities and participate in appraisal and postgraduate educational activities.

Education and Training

- The post is recognised by the NHS England NW and Specialist Advisory Committee in Paediatric Dentistry as providing suitable advanced training in the specialty.
- The successful candidate will have ample opportunity and every encouragement to build on the knowledge, skills and abilities already gained through NTN training.
- 3. Opportunities exist to gain special experience in:
 - a. IV Sedation
 - b. Complex Dental Trauma management
 - c. Comprehensive management of children with complex medical conditions
 - d. Paediatric Oral Surgery / Oral medicine
 - e. Multidisciplinary management of dental anomalies / hypodontia
 - f. Cleft Lip and Palate
- 4. Regular appraisals of progress with an Educational Supervisor will be expected.
- 5. Attendance at appropriate management training courses will be encouraged.
- 6. Participation in the ARCP process is required.
- 7. Completion of the Advanced Competencies for Paediatric Dentistry will be expected. The trainee will be required to demonstrate clinical experience via their clinical logbook.
- 8. Full participation in clinical education seminars with other Specialist Trainees is expected. This may include the delivery of presentations and attendance at appropriate study days and courses.
