Description of training post including Educational Supervisor if known	<p>A Specialty Trainee ST1 appointment in Paediatric Dentistry is available for training to a Consultant Level.</p> <p>The objective of this training program is to produce a Consultant Paediatric Dentist who can provide local specialist services in a primary care and/or hospital setting.</p> <p><u>Main activities and responsibilities:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To undertake specialist training in Paediatric Dentistry. • To undertake clinical procedures within the curriculum for Paediatric Dentistry. • To attend continuing education courses as appropriate. • To provide an exemplary ethical standard as a role model for students at all levels. • To take part in all aspects of clinical governance activities in the Directorate and participate in appraisal and postgraduate educational activities. <p>Clinical duties will include patient consultation clinics and operative sessions for provision of care under the direction of Consultants and Specialists in Paediatric Dentistry for patients who have been referred for secondary and tertiary care.</p> <p>However, this arrangement is indicative of the role and will be a result of balancing the needs of the Departments with those of the individual. For part-time or job-share appointments, timetables will need to be discussed individually. Timetables will be reviewed each year in line with the development needs of the individuals and opportunities for training within the wider North West region. Trainees may be expected to travel for block placements in hospitals and community dental clinics across the region.</p> <p><u>Entry Requirements</u></p> <p>The Specialty Trainee will be appointed by a committee comprising representatives of the Postgraduate Dean, Specialty Training Committee, the Teaching Hospitals, and National Panel of Specialists. Candidates must hold a registerable dental degree (B.D.S. or equivalent) and must be eligible for full registration with the GDC. Applicants will be expected to provide evidence of their competence to communicate in English.</p> <p><u>THE POST</u></p>
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		<p>It is expected that the successful candidate will initially enter into specialist training in Paediatric Dentistry and following completion of 4 yrs (full-time) training and successfully passing the DSFE, they will be eligible for a Consultant post in Paediatric Dentistry. The outline training programme has been approved by the Specialist Advisory Committee in Paediatric Dentistry and the Dean for Postgraduate Dentistry, NHS England, North West.</p> <p>The training programme would extend over a 4 year period (full time) and would be based on the SAC approved Paediatric Dentistry CCST program. Training would be based at all of the sites listed above. The successful candidate will take part in all aspects of clinical governance activities and participate in appraisal and postgraduate educational activities.</p> <p><u>Education and Training</u></p> <p>Both the UK Specialist Curriculum in Paediatric Dentistry and the generic curriculum for all speciality training programmes are embedded into the programme.</p>
