

RETURN TO TRAINING COURSE FOR PAEDIATRIC TRAINEES



This course aims to support paediatric trainees as they return to training following a period of planned leave or prolonged absence. The course is free to attend and split over two days and paediatric trainees of all grades are welcome. There will be a team of experienced paediatricians and neonatologists as well as fellow trainees delivering the sessions in a relaxed and friendly environment.
