My journey in dentistry began at the University of Bristol, where I completed my undergraduate training and

graduated with Distinctions across multiple disciplines, including Restorative Dentistry and Orthodontics. I went on to gain further experience in a mixed Private and NHS practice in Ascot, followed by a year of intensive training in Restorative Dentistry at the Royal London Hospital. During this time, I also completed postgraduate exams to gain Membership of the Joint Dental Faculties at the Royal College of Surgeons of England.

I've always been drawn to complex treatment planning and long-term patient care, which led me to complete a Master of Science in Dental Implantology with Distinction at the University of Bristol, a Diploma in Implant Dentistry from the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, and a four-year Master of Clinical Dentistry in Fixed and Removable Prosthodontics at King's College London, also awarded with Distinction.

At our practice, I provide a full range of advanced restorative and implant treatments, as well as Invisalign and Enlighten tooth whitening. I also lecture nationally and internationally for King's College London on dental implantology and tooth surface loss.

Importantly, I've been involved in foundation training for several years and genuinely enjoy supporting newly qualified dentists.
