-  Reaches a working diagnosis / analysis
-  Offers a safe patient centred management plan
-  Manages co-morbidity appropriately
-  Provides follow up/safety net

-  Uses open questions appropriately
-  Clarifies and explores cues offered
-  Listens and shows curiosity
-  Uses closed questions appropriately
