8	Description of the training post	<p><i>The post holder will join a team of SCD trainees across the Northwest and will be primarily based in the Special Care Dentistry Department of Liverpool University Dental Hospital.</i></p> <p><i>The StR timetable ensures flexibility in training across all aspects of the individual's training needs. The weekly timetable will include dedicated clinical training sessions where the StR will train alongside the consultants and specialists in Special Care dentistry on an individual basis. There is also dedicated time for clinical administration, study and audit activities. The timetable changes every 6 months according to the needs of the individual trainee.</i></p> <p><i>In addition, the StR will spend clinical time with consultants and specialists in other dental specialties including Oral Medicine, Oral Surgery and Restorative Dentistry. Formal training in provision of oral healthcare under conscious sedation will be provided as required by the individual StR. Experience in the provision of comprehensive dental care under GA is provided in Dental & General Hospital settings.</i></p> <p><i>The clinical training will include the provision of the full range of special care dentistry for patients referred to the Dental Hospital and Wirral Community Dental Service by dental and medical practitioners and by Consultants in other specialties.</i></p> <p><i>Work pattern: Mon-Fri 9am-6pm with 1 hour lunch break (40 hours per week)</i></p>
