The practice has been providing NHS Dental services to the local community and beyond for over 50 years.</p> <p>Warrington is a vibrant town with plenty of high quality shops and restaurants and is easily commutable with excellent transport links. Due to the central location of the practice, there is a nearby central bus station and two train stations. There are also plenty of nearby car parking sites .</p> <p>The practice has operated as a UDC throughout the covid pandemic and we also provide outreach placement for the Liverpool University Dental students.</p> <p>Treatment is carried out from 7 surgeries providing the core of NHS dental treatments as well as private and independent care options. Any foundation dentist appointed to the practice will be exposed to a wide variety of clinical cases. From dentures to dental implants and gum treatments to aesthetic tooth coloured fillings- we provide a full and comprehensive dental service. We also have a visiting dentist who provides special interest endodontics .</p>

	<p>We have a fantastic dental team comprising 7 dentists, 1 therapist, 2 head nurses and 2 managers as well as multiple nurses and reception staff. We are a friendly, laid back but professional team who provide excellent support and an open door policy that encourages learning.</p> <p>The practice is computerised using Exact SOE and Examine Pro for digital radiographs. We also have an intra oral scanner (Trios 3) and are looking at investing in a second scanner and CBCT machine in the near future. We use apex locators and the Wave 1 Gold system for endodontics and have a practice SLR camera with ring flash and macro lens . We also have a surgical motor and electro cautery kit</p>
