vision and mission

The vision for the VRN is for every person living or working in Lancashire to feel safe from violence and violent crime.

The mission has 4 strands:

1. Prevention

Prevention and early intervention are at the core of the violence reduction network. They focus on community and partnerships strengths to reduce, prevent and respond to violence.

2. Enforcement

They work closely with partners to use civil and criminal remedies. They are committed to swift, visible justice for those who commit violence.

3. Evidence

They promote a learning culture and develop evidence of good practice. They take a system-wide approach across Lancashire partnerships.

4. Culture

They take a public health approach to tacking violence. They build on our community links and partnerships, including working with people with lived experience, to reduce and prevent violence. They work to build a trauma informed approach across the county's services.

- Prison and families
- Trauma informed Lancashire

The core team consists of A Director, Superintendent, Chief Inspector, data lead, comms lead supported by Education leads and Children Social Care Leads. The team is absolutely fantastic and it is a great placement.
